The *Ruien Energy Storage NV* energy storage project is a 25 MW / 100 MWh battery storage system supporting the clean energy transition in the country. The system will help regulate fluctuations in the grid, such as changes in wind energy production. It will also improve revenues by maintaining energy frequency and reliability. The system is the largest in Belgium to-date and is expected to be commissioned later this year.

The energy storage system is supplied by Wärtsilä under an extended equipment delivery and a long-term service agreement.

The facility includes <u>Wärtsilä's GridSolv Quantum</u> fully-integrated and modular energy storage system, as well as the <u>GEMS Digital Energy Platform</u>, Wärtsilä's sophisticated energy management system. GEMS will ensure optimal performance for specified use cases that will maintain reliability of electricity supply, including reserve power, frequency control response, capacity dispatch and voltage support.

Energy storage projects like this will play an increasingly important role in balancing Belgium's grid as the country prepares to phase out nuclear power by 2025 and continues offshore wind energy deployments.
